- Usage Instruction**
- 1 Click the button of the desired site name on the venue list, then the 360 VR tour will start. If you have troubles, such as the map and buttons are not showing, clear the cache and reload the web site or try private mode.
 - 2 Depends on the tours, upon the beginning of the tours, you will be requested to select whether you are preferred to play background music or not. In such cases, select "Yes" or "No."
 - 3 A map is shown on the right side of the 360 VR tour screen. Adjust the map size for your convenience and enjoy the tour.
 - 4 The start screen of the tour has icons such as: "Site Information", "Arrow", "Home" and "Next". Refer to the icon list below for explanation.
 - 5 There are no fixed routes to follow in the 360 VR tour, however it would be easier to explore the virtual tour by following artist numbers.

|  | It shows the location you can move on the map.
Click the icon, then you will move to the location. |
|  | It shows your current location and the direction of your view. |
|  | The icon at the bottom of the screen will show you the thumbnails of each view. |
|  | Click one of the thumbnails, you can move to the location directly. |
|  | You can move in the direction of the arrow. |
|  | It closes the 360VR tour and return to the BIWAKO BIENNALE website. |
|  | You can go to the next 360VR tour by following the site number. |
|  | It shows the photos of the exhibit artwork. |
|  | It shows a video of the exhibit artwork. |
|  | It shows the information and photos of the workshop. |
|  | It shows the information and photos of the concert. |
